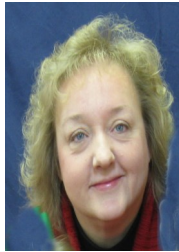

Lowcountry Disaster Relief Training

 - \$30 for new volunteers
 (or untrained/undeployed within 6 years)
 - \$15 for returning volunteers

Training provided by the South Carolina Baptist Convention Disaster Relief Team.

- Training modules offered will include:
- New Volunteer Orientation
 - Chainsaw Unit
 - Fixed Kitchen Food Unit

The cost for new volunteers or those who have not been trained or deployed within the last 6 years is \$30, which covers training, training materials, background screening, ID badge, lanyard, DR hat, coffee and snacks.

The cost for returning volunteers who have been trained or deployed within the last 6 years is \$15, which covers training, updated background screening, a new ID badge, coffee and snacks. Payments (cash or check) will be taken at the event registration table. Checks can be made payable to the Savannah River Baptist Association.
